The 2 pathways to the Bachelor of Science Degree in Emergency Management are as follows:

1. Associates Degree in Emergency Services from PUC
2. Associated degree from another institution - Public Safety, Law Enforcement, Criminal Justice, Emergency Services, Fire Science, Business, Psychology, etc.

The AS in Emergency Services includes all of our EMT and rescue-based courses. It prepares graduates to enter the workforce at the local level as an EMT.

- Students who have completed all required prerequisite courses upon entry can complete a B.S. in Emergency Management in just 3-5 quarters. These courses may be transferred if the student has previously taken the course (per college transfer policy).
