The application process has begun and is pending approval or denial. We project notification between August and October 2022. It is our intent to begin the program in the quarter immediately following approval, if approval is obtained.

3 OPTIONS FOR ADMISSION

A. Traditional Entry:

For students with a BS degree in Nursing.

- For students with a BS degree in Nursing

B. Bridge Program:

For Registered Nurses with a Non-Nursing BA or BS degree.

- The Bridge Program option enables students to enter directly into the Master of Science in Nursing program.

C. RN-to-MS Fast Track:

For associate-degree or diploma-prepared Registered Nurses seeking to proceed directly to the Master of Science in Nursing Degree from the BSN program.
