General Info:

- 1. The tuition waivers cover 12 credits per summer (usually equivalent to 4 classes). 2. Instructors will email textbook information and course details in a welcome email several weeks prior to the start of class along with how to access Canvas.
- 3. Canvas is the online platform for the classes.
- 4. Synchronous means meeting live on Zoom or Teams during the times indicated. 5. Asynchronous means no live meetings working through online modules with readings, discussions, and learning activities on your own time generally at your pace within the start and end time of the class.
